# Exhibition of self-defense for students of elementary school in Poděbrady



On the 6<sup>th</sup> February we organized demo lessons of self-defense in the base gym of the Taekwon-Do Lions club in elementary school of T.G. Masaryk.

Big thanks to International instructor Viktor Stein, IV. Dan, trainer of the Taekwon-Do Sparring Mnichovice for guiding through the whole day. We also have to give thanks to his students of Čerčany club – Jiří Beneš, I. Dan, Vendula Loušová, 2. Kup, Martin Bambas, 2. Kup and Marek Bambas, 5. Kup for their assistance in these lessons.

Ten classes of the elementary school students have participated in the lessons during the day. In their lesson each group learnt few things about prevention of dangerous situations and principles of safe behavior of children in the real environment of the cities. After explanation and demonstration of some self-defense techniques, the students could try to perform them by themselves. They tried getting out of arm grab, neck grab and body grab. During their practicing, the students were advised by already mentioned assistants and also trainer of the Lions school, Kamil Kolofík, IV. Dan, the organizer of the event.

After the self-defense practice the students were taught how to properly make a fist and how to perform basic punch and kick. The students could try executing both these easy techniques on kick shields under the supervision of our instructors.

At the end of the lesson the students learnt essential information about Taekwon-Do in the world of sport.

I believe, that although we were under constant pressure of time, we helped the children to understand such a complex subject and to make their environment safer.



#### Preparing for the European Championship and the Championship of Czech Republic



Since autumn are our representatives of Taekwon-Do Sparring Mnichovice club preparing for the European Championship in Maribor. Apart of those trainings "Training of talented youth" took place twice, where wider selection of representatives practiced for the Championship of Czech Republic, which will be held in Benátky nad Jizerou on the 19th of May.

First training session happened at the beginning of March. A three-hour training was split into three stages. In the first stage the trainees practiced kicks in movement and exercises in pairs for combinations of kicks and punches. After a short break the second stage began. This one was given to tulls and training of more complex techniques where students had to not only use their arms and legs, but also give a thought to their moves. The final stage was about rehearsing and perfecting special techniques.

We met for the second time on the last weekend of March. During the first lesson we practiced duel combinations on kick-shields and later with sparring partner. After the muchneeded rest tulls came up. In the last part we trained their high-potential for special techniques. At the end of the lesson we revised tulls and then headed home.

Thanks to all the attendants, we are looking forward for our next meeting which is already set on the second weekend of April.



#### Strančice training camp



We spent the first week of February in a training camp.

January passed quickly and apart of ten training lessons in one month we, the trainers, were preparing a weekend training camp. We wanted to make it something new and different opposed to previous years. That's why we equipped the basketball gym, with which are all of our students familiar, with stands for power breaking and special techniques, a lot of stands for training of jumps, bounces and accuracy of breaking techniques and also an obstacle course.

Most of our time was given to Wirok and T-ki. We spent hours with intense practice of jump kicks and drills of power breaking accuracy. An important part were also individual advices and corrections, passing on trainers' experience for both trainings and contests. We made video analyzes of the practices, which helped our students to find their weak spots and work on them.

The kids enjoyed the obstacle course, whereas the favorite of adults was the Wirok stands. Often it wasn't only about the technique, but more about endurance, self-control and a strong mind, the principles of Taekwon-Do. We give our thanks to the president of Czech national Taekwon-Do Union.

#### **European Championship**



At 11th April our team start journey to Maribor – city of EC 2018. From Czech National Taekwon-Do Union we had two competitors Jiří Beneš and Jakub Roubal and two coaches Kamil Kolofík and Viktor Stein. Journey was without any complications so at the afternoon we arrived to do weight-in and registration.

Next day we moved to sporthall, where we enjoyed Opening Ceremony. And then the competition started. Our first battle was Tull cathegory of Jirka Beneš – he lost because of innacurate and insufficiently technical performance of kicks. Morning there was also special techniques cathegory where we had our competitor Jakub Roubal – he did 2 kicks very good (each for 3 points) but it was still not much to get medal. He ended at nice 7th place. Afternoon Jakub had his Tull cathegory. He lost first round because he did not shouted out the name of tull.

Friday we was prepared for Jirka's next cathegory – Sparring. His match started very well, Jirka was better and had more points but his opponent found cranny in Jirka's blocks so the result was that Jirka lost. Nevertheless Jirka gained a lot of experiences during whole EC, so we trust that his next competition will be much better (this was first time for Jirka to start in Junior cathegory).

At evening our trainers participated of AETF congress as official representatives of Czech Republic. One of the main points was also holding of next European Cups and Championships. We are looking forward to year 2020 when we will visit our neighbours in Slovakia.

Saturday we had free morning so we went to do some sightseeing, e.g. to very nice hill named Piramida surrounded by grapewine and also to world oldest bush of grapevine (was planted before more than 400 years). Afternoon we started our last cathegory – Sparring Seniors – where Jakub have participated. First Jakub's opponent was competitor from Spain. It was very tight match but thanks to better timing Jakub won. Jakub lost his second match with opponent was from Scotland (participant of final round in this cathegory). This day ended by Galashow and some final matches.

We had to mention that from Czech Republic there were more 6 competitors from Czech Taekwon-Do Federation – they fighted bravely, Alex Vištal won once in Tulls and Barbora Jílkova broke one technique in Wi-rok and gained 3 points.

On Sunday we set out to way home. During our journey we went sightseeing in Linc (as part of Dallyon).

#### Schooling of trainers and umpires

# Open Czech Republic Championship Taekwon-Do ITF



In early morning on May 19th we were getting ready for the greatest competition of the season - Open Czech Republic Championship Taekwon-Do ITF. The championship took place in the beautiful gym of Benátky nad Jizerou, as the previous years. 125 contenders from 7 schools applied this year, including foreign contestants from SENTUR school from Slovenia led by their instructor Vahid Drapič, Dan V.

This time the preparation of the equipment was more complicated than the organizers were used to because of an electronic system used for keeping track of points and progress of the contestants. Thanks to that the contenders could see on big screens not only who is in the ring right now and how many points they have, but also who should get ready for the next fight. The judges also used the system to rate and everything was processed by a computer, which made the whole competition quicker and easier to handle.

After the ceremonial and judges being instructed in the usage of the evaluating software the championship officially began at 10am. After that, everything was in the usual order. Juniors started off the tul contest and the senior contestants finished it. The results were announced after each category, so, for example, the kids, who came only to compete in tuls wouldn't have to wait all day for their rewards. Throughout the day one part of the gym was dedicated purely to special techniques and power breaking. The individual tul category was finished by noon, meaning we could move along to duels. One ring was reserved for the category of team tuls. Unfortunately, this one took longer than expected due to the unparalleled number of teams, but in the end there was time for everyone. The team of Sparring school Mnichovice won in this category, Siláci, the team from Silla school was second and the team from Milovice took the third place.



### Open Czech Republic Championship Taekwon-Do ITF



Even the youngest competitors have shown honorable performance combining strength, swiftness and and great courage. Medical help was necessary on few occasions in the juniors and seniors categories but everything was taken care of quickly and the contestants quickly returned back to action. In the afternoon the results were announced continuously once again, so no one had to wait too long for their medals. The very last part of the championship was model sparring. Sadly, only two pairs attended this category. However, they deserve our respect since for this category, the pair has to prepare a 1 minute long fight, which has to be performed as real and as synchronized as possible. That is nowhere near easy. After all categories were finished, the best contenders in each category were announced. Because many scores were tied in the top positions, only the best juniors were announced this time. Those were Vid Vehovar (Sentur) in men's category and in the female category Aneta Nekorancová (Ge-Baek). Both received great trophies - Congratulations!

After the last announcement, we said goodbye to everyone and started packing up equipment like tatami, PCs, stands, etc. We give our thanks to everyone who helped us with setting up the equipment in the morning and packing it in the afternoon. Also the judges deserve our thanks, it literally wouldn't be possible without them. Another big "Thank you" belongs to Robert Pokorný for providing us with great audio system which could be heard even in a gym full of training people and fans. Also we give our thanks to the contenders for their good manners during the championship. Thank you everyone, we are already looking forward to seeing all of you again.

After short but careful warm-up we did some drills in pairs to improve technique and speed of kicks. As next we tried some blocks, side steps and combinations of kicks and punches. Second part of training was about tulls and basic techniques from them. After 4-hour training we look after next meeting in October.



#### AHAC cup Sentjur Slovenia



At Friday 28th September evening, our team of 11 members set out to Slovenia to take part in AHAC Cup in city Sentjur.
